


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What is a Trademark?

- Registered trademarks can be licensed or sold, providing a source of revenue for the business.




Trademark Classes

Famous Trademark Classes in India




Steps to Register a Trademark




Conduct a trademark search to ensure the mark is available for registration.



File the trademark application with the appropriate authorities.



Wait for the examination and review of the application.



Publication of the trademark in the trademark journal.



Opposition proceedings, if any.



Registration of the trademark.

Conducting a Trademark Search

- A trademark search is conducted to ensure that the proposed mark is not already registered or being used by others in the same or similar industry.
- A trademark search can be conducted online using the Indian Trademark Registry's database or through a trademark agent.



Filing the Trademark Application

- The trademark application can be filed online or through a trademark agent.
- The application must include details about the applicant, the mark, and the goods or services for which the mark will be used.
- The application must also include a statement of use or intent to use the mark.



Examination and Review of the Trademark Application

- The trademark office will examine the application to ensure that it meets the requirements for registration.
- If there are any objections or issues, the applicant will be notified, and a response must be filed within a specific time frame.
- The application will be published in the trademark journal if it is in order.




Publication of the Trademark in the Trademark Journal

- Once the application is published in the trademark journal, there is a 3-month window for anyone to oppose the mark's registration.
- If there is no opposition or if the opposition is unsuccessful, the mark will proceed to registration.




Opposition Proceedings


- If an opposition is filed, the applicant will be allowed to respond and make arguments in favor of registration.
- If the opposition is successful, the application will be rejected.
- If the opposition is unsuccessful, the mark will proceed to registration.



Registration of the Trademark


- Once the mark is registered, the applicant will receive a registration certificate.
- The registration is valid for 10 years and can be renewed indefinitely.
- The registered mark can be used with the symbol [®]
